1.1 Project title: New vision of partneship: KORFBALL

1.2 Focus area/objective: Education and Capacity Building, Improving hard and soft skills for the 21st century through formal and non-formal educational methods

Short description of the project:

In the project we would like to give chance for Physical Education teachers and teachers that are interested to learn a new, different kind of sport. During the project they learn the basics of the korfbal, why is this sport good in development of the motoric, cognitive and emotional skills and how can it develop the whole personality of the participant people (children and adult also), who get in touch in it. If they learn the basics of this sport, they can teach in a new perspective, where they can promote gender equality, can develop social skills and be as inclusive as it possible.

2. PROJECT RELEVANCE AND CONTEXT

2.1 What is the main issue that your project would like to focus on? What is the current situation that you wish to change?

The main intent is to involve new teachers and new institutes (primary and secondary schools) into the world of Korfbal, to show them how this sport can help to build a better and healthier society. Today Korfbal is an upcoming sport in the V4 region. With the project we would like to emphasize the Korfbal, and bring out its positive effects on the society. We can say, that this sport has his unique rules. There are many mixed gender sports in the world, but this is the only one, where equality is on the line. That is the reason why this could be the best way to promote health, as a mental-social-physical state of wellness. All of the participating countries have only a few trainers, who are interested in the theory and practise of korfbal-teaching. These people usually do Korfbal, because they like it. To do something in a proper way, you need to focus on it. But if people /the crowd have/ has no intention in your work, there won't be enough progression in creating a healthier, sportier society, which Korfbal could develop. We need to show the children and the schools what korfbal is, and what it can give us to create a better world, to live in a better and healthier society. During the last year IVF project of the four country the korfbal is slowly spreading, even in this pandemic times (trainings depending on retrictions), we have totally 36 new coaches in the four countries (4 polish, 6 czech, 9 slovak, 17 hungarian) who have started korfbal in this season, but we should have more to bring this opportunity for the less developed regions also.

2.2 What should be done to address this issue/problem? How does your project contribute to the solution?

Our aim with the project is to improve education, educational partnership, and competition between the Participants through a special event. It is important for us, to help the development of Korfbal in the region by involving new teachers, new institutes draw attention to this sport, by a special trainer course. We want to teach the basics of Korfbal, teach participants gender equality and cooperation, and respect for weaker and less gifted people and thus raise decent people. To improve the teachers, to develop their progress, we would like to create a Korfbal Coaching Course. After the course there would be 8-8 new korfbal trainers in every V4 country (32 total, the proportion of each also depends on the pandemic situation, how can people travel), who can bring experience back to his/her schools, and can show children and school, to the leaders that korfbal is more than a sport, its the best way to show everyone that we could be more open-minded and empathic, and we could create good relationships in a healthy way. Also during the course we would like to show "special" korfbal for handicapped people. With the new people and knowledge we would like to spread the importance of "being active for life" and "lifelong learning", both are - in our point of view - the bases of well-being and health, in every age and every scene of life.

2.3. What added value does your project bring to the already existing practices? What is the innovative element in your proposal?

We would like to bring 2 specialists for the project from the International Korfbal Federation, they has the best experts in the world of korfbal. Their basic knowledge in the aftergrowth development should be implemented into the system of each country in the V4 area, also the special, handicapped program has relevance in our plan of progression. Also we would like to involve the education committees of the four federation to help in the program, whats the main development areas in their countries. We would like to give a special, unusual point of view with the coaching course, because korfbal is unique, but to show it to someone, you need to believe in it. We want to show for the participants that we believe in the power of equality, gender equality and cooperation, and how to respect weaker and less gifted and thus raise decent people. We would like to give equipment to the teachers with a sort of enthusiasm, that everybody can do for a better future.

2.4 What is the regional relevance of your proposal?

We expect from the project to encourage people that to be healthy, to draw their attention to a healthy lifestyle, that doesn't have to be unenjoyable. Influence the children with a different point of view help for the adults too. With the program we can involve adults to the world sports, only a few of them would be "active" sportman or sportwomen, but most of them going to be parents of the children whom plays, fan, who follow up the teams, sponsors. We would like to involve the handicapped people also, because today it's much more harder for a "breakout" for them, we would like to help them in it, and create the healthy life opportunities for them, as the part of our "being active for life" vision. We believe that the project could help people to accept the difference, in every scene of the society.

2.5. How would you describe your organization's experience in dealing with the proposed topic? Have you previously implemented similar projects?

Our organization have a few project in the last 20 years to involve new teachers and trainers. Most of it was succesful, they had good evaluations about the courses, the programs, but the afterlife of them was not efficient enough, after a few years most of the participants dissapeared because of the low chance of emulation, low number of teams. Today, by the LTAD view we have better championship system, we have more clubs and more children, in more settlements. We have experience from before (national and international), good and bad also, so we can make much better progression right now. Our last project with the IVF was very succesful all the participant people and federations, and also the International Korfball Federation was satisfied with it, both in organizing and content. The new korfball coahes that started to teach said that the most of the children are interested in this new view, and lot of them have developed in cognitive and emotional way, children who started this sport have less aggression and conflict, they have turned to be more empathic and helpful to each other even in just short time.

Specific result	Contribution to the project's overall goal
Teach the basics of LTAD, LLL and Korfball	Most of the teachers don't know what is the most effective way to train children in an exciting and entertaining way. Showing the key points could help the teachers to assimilate/accomodate. With this the participants get a new point of view.
Help to learn equality and cooperation among genders, teach them how to respect and accept difference between people	With the unique rules, the difference in dimension (such as height or weight, gender) dissapears. This teach the players and children to have respect for everybody else. We want to raise decent people, with that we can show equal rules, where everybody can achieve succes.

5. DISSEMINATION AND FOLLOW-UP

5.1 What activities will you carry out to share the results of the project outside your organization and partners?

The Hungarian Korfball Federation have good connections with the media, we can involve the hungarian national television and newspapers also for promotion of the program. Last time (in 2021) our IVF project has been part of the V4 News (the tv magazine of hungarian television M1 for the Visegrad Countries) which has positive feedback also from the ministries. The federations undertake that they follow the progress of the participants after the project, help them to develop the schools progress. The Hungarian Korfball Federation plan to create regional centers to help to build relations between schools, spread korfball in the country. We plan to hold "inside" school tournaments, and regional tournaments for institutes along the "normal" national championships. We would like to promote the program on leisure events also, such as sport festivals, teacher training programs, as a equipment to make a healthier society, in body, mind and soul.

5.2 Do you plan any activities in the future which will build on the results of this project?

We would like to organize a school korfball championship (regional school cups, international school cups ...) beside the normal national championships, to make a competition on a lower level, as a recreational level. If the students are more interested in it, they can step forward to the competition level, and even to the national selection level. From our projects there are few players who have won the U15 European Korfball Championship in 2021, that proves even from schools they can reach to the top level without sport clubs, if they are enthusiastic enough and have good mentality not just for sport, but for school, learning and life also.

IV. DELIVERABLES

I Korfball Coaching course (Event–Private), Gárdony, HU

18/08/2022–21/08/2022

Trainers course with attendance of 32 trainers or teachers from V4 countries. Each country may enter up to 8 participants. Event taking place in Hungary as the applicant of the project. 3 nights (4 days) course during an extended weekend (by plan). 2 foreign and 2 domestic lecturers. At the last one day there would be children involved from U15 age group for the program. During the program there are theoretical and practical session also, at least 10 together. With the children the participants can receive practical knowledge and experience. The participants can master the informations in procedural way over just the declarative way.

Direct target groups:

Teachers at primary and secondary schools, Korfball trainers: 32

Selection/outreach: Teachers interested in korfball and its further implementation in their school activities. Trainers of teams or national selections, to improve development programs. 8/country Basically P.E. teachers have been chosen with competition (applying) by the federations (of each country, 8 participants/country). The federations decide the requirements of the selection. Every participants need to speak english, because the course is in english language.

Children and youth between 10 and 15 years of age: 40

Selection/outreach: Children from local schools and korfball teams, selected by the Hungarian Korfball Association. The children are going to participate on a korfball camp organized by the federation. This is another project of the HKA.

Dissemination/promotion

After the project event, we would like to create regional and international school camp and tournament for the participant teachers (school teams) which takes place in different V4 countries every year. We would like to involve new schools/teachers with every program, if its possible we would like to invite teams/schools from WB and EP region either.

Role of the applicant and project partners

The preparation of the project preparation is up to the Hungarian Korfball Association. In the implementation the IKF lecturers and other lecturers (mainly hungarians) take part, also the organizer and volunteer staff helps them. The Czech, Slovakian and the Polish partner helps for us to find the best participants in their country (8 for each nation) to spread this sport, this new view as much as possible. After the project each country have the chance to involve approximately 2000 new student into a healthy, respectful program, where they not only get sport, they get a view, how they can do it in a different way to change the world, to build a better world, start from the V4 region. After the program we plan international tournaments for the participant teachers and new teams.
